- High consumer protection through avoidance of hazardous chemicals



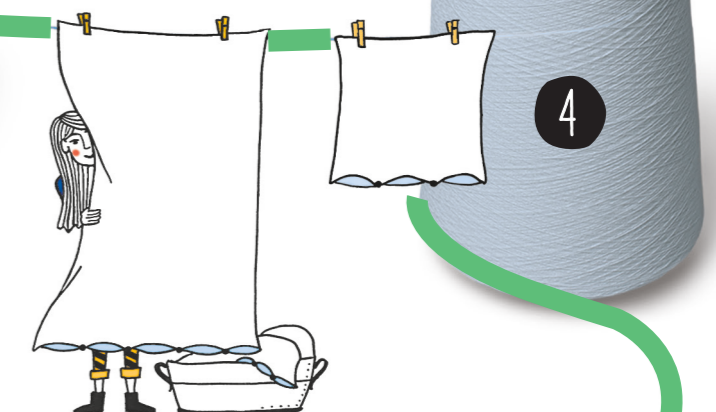
SEWING

- are harmless to health and systematically tested in the laboratory by one of the OEKO-TEX® member institutes and have been awarded the state textile seal Green Button.

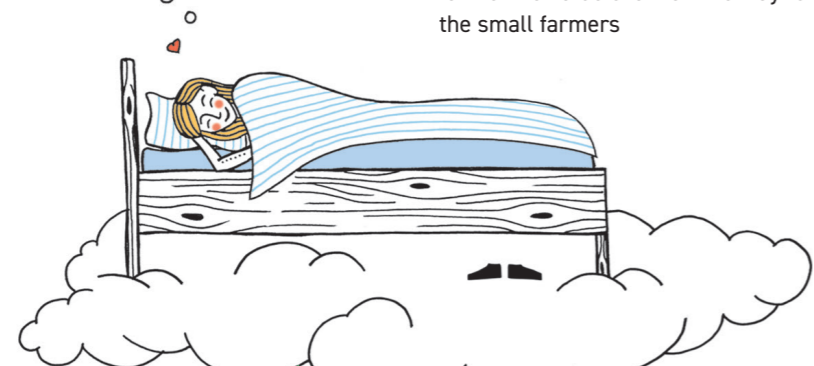
